

## PENARTH MINE nr CORWEN

Around SJ107424. Park in layby on A5 just before Lldiart y Parc on the Corwen side and walk uphill through village then right up old tramway or go up through one of two farms that have rights of way that intersect the tramway. Good sized spoilheap and traverse around it to reach the quarry. Obvious hole in wall. Left is smaller workings and loads of bats. Take care at end as there is a hole in the floor down to the lower bigger stuff (which you can walk down to by going right just inside the mine.)

Turning right just inside the mine is the big stuff. Basically just follow a lot of railway tracks underground. There are several levels and it's a good 2hour Sunday trip.

No tackle is required to do this trip.

I recommend the station café on the nearby Llangollen railway for food/tea afterwards !!
